

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING WASHTENAW COUNTY REPRESENTATIVES TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MICHIGAN ASSOCIATION OF LOCAL PUBLIC HEALTH FOR TWO YEAR TERMS EXPIRING DECEMBER 31, 1999

WASHTENAW COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

WHEREAS, in 1985 an organization known as the Michigan Association of Local Health Department was established to represent the interests of public health at the community level to the Michigan legislature and the Michigan Department of Public Health; and

WHEREAS, Washtenaw County is entitled to one representative and an alternate to the Board of Directors, one of whom shall be the County Health Officer or his/her designee and the other can be either a County Commissioner or a member of the Board of Health; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the County that the current Medical Health Officer, Ellen Clement, be appointed to this Board during her tenure; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby appoints the following representatives to the Michigan Association of Local Community Health for two-year terms expiring December 31, 1999:

- 2)Cmsr. Chockley, alternate
