

A RESOLUTION IN MEMORY OF KATHLEEN A. CHAPMAN

WASHTENAW COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

April 15, 1998

WHEREAS, Kathleen "Katie" Chapman was a lifelong resident of Washtenaw County and the Chelsea community, who was described by many as a "natural leader", and was a woman who was loved by the entire community; and

WHEREAS, Katie was a former Washtenaw County Employee, who served the Extension Service for 25 years, before retiring in 1976; and

WHEREAS, following her County retirement, she became known as a tireless volunteer in the Chelsea community, serving as a charter member of Faith In Action, as well as her memberships in the Chelsea Rotary, Washtenaw County 4-H, and the Chelsea Hospital Auxiliary; and

WHEREAS, she was well known for her religious devotion, serving St. Mary's Catholic Church, the Lansing Diocesan Council of Catholic Women, the Chelsea Knights of Columbus Auxiliary, and St. Louis Center; and

WHEREAS, Katie served the Village of Chelsea as it's Treasurer from 1986-1996; and

WHEREAS, she was named "Woman of the Year" by the American Business Women's Club in 1976, was nominated for the President's Volunteer Action Award in 1994, became Chelsea's Citizen of the Year in 1995, received the Friendship Award from St. Louis Center in 1996, and recently received the Paul Harris Fellowship, Rotary's highest award
