

## **A RESOLUTION IN MEMORY OF AUDDIE SHELBY**

### **WASHTENAW COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**

June 17, 1998

WHEREAS, Washtenaw County Government, its Board of Commissioners, Drain Commissioner, and Director and staff of the Department of Environment and Infrastructure Services, has among its highest priorities, the protection of Washtenaw County's environmental resources and the health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Auddie Shelby, Augusta Township citizen, environmental activist, and chair of Local 898 UAW Toxic Waste Squad, inspired Washtenaw County officials in our work to fight toxic contamination, to support protection of the environment and to defend the right of all citizens to a healthy and safe place in which to live and raise their children; and

WHEREAS, Auddie Shelby's death of Friday, May 29, 1998, represents an irreplaceable loss, both to his family and the larger community

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Washtenaw County Government expresses its deepest sympathy to the Shelby family, for its loss of an inspirational, loving, ethical and committed family member and community leader

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Washtenaw County Government does hereby express its gratitude to the Shelby family and to Auddie's memory for his years of work to protect the environment and quality of life in Washtenaw County, and its deepest regret for the loss of a very special member of Washtenaw County's community.
