

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE GRANT FUNDING AGREEMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$16,000 BETWEEN THE MICHIGAN SUPREME COURT AND THE WASHTENAW COUNTY TRIAL COURT FOR THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 1998 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 1998

WASHTENAW COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

June 17, 1998

WHEREAS, the Washtenaw County Trial Court, consisting of the Circuit Court, the 14-A district Court, the 14-B District Court, the 15<sup>th</sup> District Court and the Probate Court, is designated by the Supreme Court as a demonstration project for trial court unification and has been awarded a third-year grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the funding consists of \$10,000 in new funds plus a carryover of \$6000 from unspent 1997 grant funds, for a total of \$16,000; and

WHEREAS, there is no match requirement under the agreement; and

WHEREAS, the funds will be used primarily to cover the cost of the special management consulting services needed by the court to help in the ongoing transition and to provide training relevant to the unified judicial information system that is a central element of the project; and

WHEREAS, this matter has been reviewed by the Finance Office, Human Resources, Corporation Counsel, the County Administrator's Office and the Ways and Means Committee

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby accepts the agreement in the amount of \$16,000 between the Michigan Supreme Court and the Washtenaw County Trial Court for the period of January 1, 1998 through December 31, 1998 as on file with the County Clerk

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners hereby amends the budget as attached
