

A RESOLUTION ON RECONCILIATION OF COUNTY MEETING CALENDARS

WASHTENAW COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

February 3, 1999

WHEREAS, the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners appoints the membership of many boards, committees, councils, and commissions (hereafter Special Committees); and

WHEREAS, these board and commissions provide important oversight and guidance to the Board of Commissioners in policy and implementation for County functions; and

WHEREAS, the citizens, staff, and County Commissioners should be able to attend meetings of the Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, Washtenaw County Commissioners should be able to attend meetings of Special Committees; and

WHEREAS, staff who serve on County Special Committees may be needed, and should be available, to answer questions and provide information for citizens, Commissioners or the County Administrator at meetings of the Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners adopts an annual calendar of meetings in January of each year

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Special Committees appointed by the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners will coordinate annual calendars with the Board of Commissioners each year, beginning in December 1999 for calendars adopted in January 2000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no Special Committee will arrange the annual calendar of meetings for that board so as to conflict with scheduled meetings of the Board of Commissioners as adopted in the annual calendar.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, except as waived in writing by the Chair of the Board of Commissioners, no staff support, funding, or other County resources will be used for meetings of Special Committees held in conflict with the adopted annual calendar of the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners beginning in January 2000.
