

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE BROWNFIELD REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY FOR
WASHTENAW COUNTY

WASHTENAW COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

June 9, 1999

WHEREAS, on April 7, 1999, the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners adopted a Resolution of Intent to establish a Brownfield Redevelopment Authority (Res. 99-0072), as it had determined that it is in the best interest of the public to facilitate the implementation of plans relating to the identification and treatment of environmentally distressed areas and the promotion of site revitalization in Washtenaw County; and

WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners described in that Resolution of Intent, the "Proposed Brownfield Redevelopment Zone," and declared its intention to provide for the operation of a Brownfield Redevelopment Authority for County (the "Authority") pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of the Brownfield Redevelopment Financing Act, being Act 381 of the Public Acts of the State of Michigan of 1996, as amended (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, on May 5, 1999, pursuant to and in accordance with the Act and the Resolution of Intent, the Board of Commissioners held a public hearing, notice of which was given as required by Section 4 (2) of the Act, on the adoption of a resolution creating the Authority and designating the boundaries of the Brownfield Redevelopment Zone within which the Authority shall exercise its powers (the "Brownfield Redevelopment Zone"); and

WHEREAS, on May 19, 1999 the Board of Commissioners established the Authority and the designation of the boundaries of the Brownfield Redevelopment Zone within which the Authority shall exercise its powers, all pursuant and in accordance with the Act; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby appoints the Brownfield Redevelopment Authority for three year terms staggered for implementation as follows:
