

A RESOLUTION SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED 1999 MILLAGE RATE TO ADJUST THE 5.50 AUTHORIZED OPERATING MILLAGE RATE TO 4.7978 AND THE .50 MILLS FOR PARKS & RECREATION TO .4985 FOR 1999 AS THE RATES PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHED BY MCL 211.34d; FOR WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 15, 1999 AT 6:45 P.M. IN THE BOARD ROOM, COUNTY ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 2 OF ACT 43 P.A. 1963, 2ND EX. SESS. WHEREAS, this matter has been reviewed by the County Administrator's office, the Finance office, Corporation Counsel, and the Ways & Means Committee

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby sets a Public Hearing on the proposed 1999 millage rate to adjust the 5.50 authorized operating millage rate to 4.7978 and the .50 mills for Parks & Recreation to .4985 for 1999 as the rates permanently established by MCL 211.34d; for Wednesday, September 15, 1999 at 6:45 p.m. in the Board Room, County Administration Building, in compliance with Section 2 of Act 43 P.A. 1963, 2nd Ex. Sess. (M.C.L.A. 141.412), Section 24e of act 206, P.A. 1893 (M.C.L.A. 211.24e), the Millage Reduction Fractions from Act 6, P.A. 1981, and Act 539, P.A. 1982 (M.C.L.A. 211.34d), and Section 6 of Act 264 P.A. 1987, (M.C.L.A. 141.471), and Section 10(3) of Act 106 P.A. 1985 (M.C.L.A. 207.630).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners directs the County Clerk/Register to cause to be published, in accordance with Public Act 5 of 1982, the following Public Notice of said hearing in a newspaper of general circulation within Washtenaw County at least six (6) days prior to such hearing:

PUBLIC NOTICE OF HEARING

ON THE PROPOSED INCREASE IN PROPERTY TAXES FOR 1999

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners will hold a Public Hearing on the Proposed 1999 Millage which includes a proposed .2232 mill increase to realize the net benefit of increases in State Equalized Valuation to the limit permitted by the Headlee Amendment, at .1267 mill increase to realize the net benefit of revenues from the State Liquor Tax and .0397 mill increase to realize the net benefit of revenues from the State Cigarette Tax, all of which increases will enable the County to establish its operating millage at 4.7978 mills and Parks & Recreation at .4985 mills.

The Board of Commissioners has complete authority to establish the number of mills to be levied from within its authorized millage rate limitation.

If adopted, the proposed additional millage will increase operating revenues from ad valorem property taxes 4.21% over such revenues generated by levies permitted without holding a hearing. If the proposed additional millage rate is not approved the operating revenue will increase by 3.15% over the preceding year's operating revenue.

The Hearing will be held on Wednesday, September 15, 1999, in the Board Room, County Administration Building, 220 North Main Street, Ann Arbor, Michigan at 6:45 p.m.

All citizens of Washtenaw County shall have the opportunity to provide written and oral comments and to ask questions concerning the proposed operating millage.
