

A Resolution ratifying the signature of the CHAIR OF THE BOARD on THE Fiscal Year (FY) 1999 School-to-Work (STW) Transitional plan APPLICATION TO THE MICHIGAN JOBS COMMISSION (Mjc) for the period of October 1, 1999 through September 30, 2000 in the amount of \$50,208 for the EMPLOYMENT TRAINING AND COMMUNITY SERVICES (ETCS) GROUP; AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN THE NOTICE OF GRANT AWARD; AMENDING THE BUDGET AND AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN DELEGATE CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, the STW Opportunities Act requires that all students have the opportunity to participate in STW activities; and

WHEREAS, this is the fourth year that Washtenaw County will be administering the School-to-Work Initiative; and

WHEREAS, the target population is the student in the K-12 system in Washtenaw County; and

WHEREAS, approval of the STW plan will allow for the delivery of services to students within Washtenaw County; and

WHEREAS, the STW Transitional program is designed to sustain Michigan's STW system and support the state's transition to the Career Preparation System (CPS); and

Whereas, these funds are targeted at the development of parental endorsed Educational Development Plans (EDP's), for all high school students; and

Whereas, the suggested essential elements of a parent-endorsed EDP are:

1. Personal Data
2. Career Goals
3. Assessment Information
4. Employment/Work History and Work-based Learning Experience
5. Educational Goals
6. Career Exploration/Career Preparation Activities
7. High School Course Selections
8. Parent or Legal Guardian Endorsement

WHEREAS, the STW Transitional plan has a budget of \$50,208; and

WHEREAS, this matter has been reviewed by the Workforce Development Board, Corporation Counsel, Finance, Human Resources, the County Administrator's Office, and the Ways and Means Committee

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby ratifies the signature of the County Administrator on the FY 1999 School To Work Transitional Plan to the Michigan Jobs Commission for the period October 1, 1999 through September 31, 2000 for the Employment

Training/Community Services Group, as on file with the County Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners takes the following actions contingent upon receipt of the grant award in conformity with the application:

- 1. Authorizing the County Administrator to sign the Notice of Grant Award
- 2. Amending the budget as attached hereto and made a part hereof
- 3. Authorizing the County Administrator to sign the delegate contracts upon review by Corporation Counsel, to be filed with the County Clerk
