

A RESOLUTION FOR WASHTENAW COUNTY MEMBERSHIP IN THE SOUTHEAST  
MICHIGAN RESOURCE CONSERVATION & DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL

WASHTENAW COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

October 20 1999

WHEREAS, the Michigan Resource Conservation & Development Councils are nonprofit natural resources organizations sponsored by the State's Conservation Districts & County Boards of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Southeast Michigan Resource Conservation & Development Council currently has as members:the Conservation Districts of Lenawee, Macomb, Monroe, Oakland, St. Clair, Washtenaw and Wayne and the County Boards of Commissioners of Lenawee, Monroe, St. Clair and Wayne, in addition to the city of Detroit, the River Raisin Watershed Council and Wayne County MSU Extension; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the Southeast Michigan Resource Conservation & Development Council have requested that Washtenaw County join this Council; and

WHEREAS, membership could allow greater regional coordination of environmental programs; and

WHEREAS, this matter has been reviewed by Corporation Counsel, Finance, the County Administrator's Office and the Ways & Means Committee

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby approves membership in the Southeast Michigan Resource Conservation & Development Council and pay the one-time membership fee in the amount of \$500.00

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners directs continued membership be dependent upon demonstration by the Southeast Michigan Resource Conservation & Development Council that projects work toward meeting identified needs (e.g., technical information, assistance) and do not compete with the environmental programs of Washtenaw County agencies or other County non-profit partners, such as Watershed Councils and others.
