

A RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING THE ANN ARBOR/YPSILANTI COMMUNITY ON THE CELEBRATION OF NATIONAL FRENCH WEEK, NOVEMBER 4-10, 1999

WHEREAS, the Michigan Chapter of the American Association of Teachers of French, a group of teachers, students and other Francophiles, is coordinating the celebration of National French Week, November 4-10, 1999; and
