

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN AN EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERFORMANCE GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF MICHIGAN FOR THE PERIOD OF OCTOBER 1, 2000 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2000

WHEREAS, since 1991 the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has required the State of Michigan to enter into agreements with each county before disbursing Emergency Management funding; and

WHEREAS, the agreement places no additional programmatic burden on the County or the Emergency Management Division; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Management Performance Grant funding will reimburse the County for 51% of the Emergency Management Director's salary and fringe package in this fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, resolution 92-0072 authorizes the Chair of the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners and the County Administrator to address functional and operational issues relating to Emergency Management; and

WHEREAS, FEMA's Emergency Management funding formula has been fairly consistent and recurring on an annual basis; and

WHEREAS, the agreement has been reviewed by the County Administrator's Office, Corporation Counsel, Human Resources, the Finance Department, and the Ways & Means Committee

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners authorizes the County Administrator to sign the Emergency Management Performance Grant Agreement for fiscal year 2000 with the State of Michigan, as on file with the County Clerk
