

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE SIGNATURE OF THE CHAIR OF THE BOARD ON THE EMPLOYMENT TRAINING AND COMMUNITY SERVICES GROUP'S WORKFORCE INVESTMENT ACT'S COMPREHENSIVE 5-YEAR PLAN TO THE MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF CAREER DEVELOPMENT FOR THE PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2000 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2005

WHEREAS, the Employment Training and Community Services (ETCS) Group is the administrator and operator of employment training programs in Washtenaw County and it is funded by the Jobs Training Partnership Act (JTPA), the Department of Labor, and the Michigan Department of Career Development to provide employment training and placements services; and

WHEREAS, the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) was implemented in 1998 to address workforce training and job training, replacing the Jobs Training Partnership Act (JTPA); and

WHEREAS, the WIA Comprehensive Plan identifies workforce investment needs, which include meeting the strong demand for management and supervisory people, hospital workers, clerical and sales persons, tradespersons, manufacturing assemblers and semi-skilled workers, mechanics and janitors; and

WHEREAS, the comprehensive plan proposes that all residents and employers will have access to Workforce Investment Act Core Services; these services are available to the general public creating a universal access system; and

WHEREAS, this matter has been reviewed by the Washtenaw County Workforce Development Board, Corporation's Counsel, the Finance Department, Human Resources, the County Administrator's Office, and the Ways and Means Committee;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby ratifies the signature of the Chair of the Board on the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Comprehensive 5-Year Plan for the period of July 1, 2000 through June 30, 2005, as on file with the County Clerk
