

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR, WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF CORPORATION COUNSEL AND THE FACILITIES MANAGEMENT DIRECTOR, TO NEGOTIATE AND SIGN A LONG-TERM PARKING AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF ANN ARBOR FOR THE ANN-ASHLEY PARKING STRUCTURE

WASHTENAW COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

WHEREAS, on March 4, 1986 Washtenaw County ("County") and the City of Ann Arbor ("City") executed an Agreement whereby the County would donate land to the City in the vicinity of Ann and Ashley streets for the construction of a parking structure and;

WHEREAS, under this Agreement, the County received 250 reduced rate parking spots in the Ann-Ashley parking structure; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement began when the Ann Ashley parking structure was officially opened on November 20, 1987 and extends for 15 years until November 19, 2002; and

WHEREAS, it is in the County's long-term interest to secure 300 parking spaces in the Ann-Ashley parking structure by means of a long-term agreement with the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has contracted with the Ann Arbor Downtown Development Authority to manage the Ann-Ashley parking structure.

WHEREAS, this matter has been reviewed by Corporation Counsel, Human Resources, Facilities Management, Finance, the County Administrator's Office and the Ways & Means Committee

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the County Administrator, with assistance from Corporation Counsel and the Facilities Management Director, to negotiate and sign an Agreement with the City of Ann Arbor and/or the Ann Arbor Downtown Development Authority to secure on a long-term basis approximately 300 parking spaces in the Ann-Ashley parking structure to be filed with the County Clerk
