**Board Action Requested:**

We are requesting adoption of the 2000 Apportionment Report. The report has been prepared by this office and has been reviewed by the Equalization Department.

In the adoption of the 1999 Apportionment Report, it was noted that Milan Public Library and Village of Dexter had an over-collection of taxes. Both units were notified to make the adjustment for the over-collection on their 2000 summer tax bills. The Village of Dexter did not make this adjustment; therefore, they are going to refund the over-collected amount to the taxpayers.

The Townships of Bridgewater, Lyndon and Superior have millage proposals on the November 7, 2000 general election ballot. If any of these pass, it will be necessary for us to submit an amended Apportionment Report for adoption at the November 15, 2000 Board of Commissioner meeting.
