

A RESOLUTION SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING ON JANUARY 17, 2001, AT A REGULAR BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS MEETING AT 6:45 P.M. IN THE BOARD ROOM, ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, FOR CONSIDERATION OF ALTERATION OF THE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF MANCHESTER

WHEREAS, Act. No. 3 of the Public Acts of 1895, as amended, requires that the Board of Commissioners hold a public hearing before ordering annexation of property to a unit of government within the County; and

WHEREAS, in order to hold a public hearing, the Village of Manchester must publish 3 consecutive notices; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Manchester has requested a hearing date of January 17, 2001, for consideration of the alteration of the Village boundary; and

WHEREAS, this matter has been reviewed by the County Clerk, the County Administrator's Office and the Corporation Counsel

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby establishes a public hearing on January 17, 2001 at a regular Board of Commissioners' meeting at 6:45 p.m. in the Board Room, Administration Building, Ann Arbor, Michigan, for consideration of alteration of the boundaries of the Village of Manchester
