

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO COMMENCE SPACE PLANNING FOR THE COUNTY COURT AND JAIL NEEDS IN JANUARY 2002.

WASHTENAW COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

WHEREAS, the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners adopted a Space Needs Policy, known as the County Space Plan, to provide for the office space needs of Washtenaw County Government; and

WHEREAS, through the County Space Plan the County Board of Commissioners has in the past authorized the following projects:

- Western County Service Center
- 200 N. Main Building
- Juvenile Detention/Day Treatment Facility
- Downtown Homeless Shelter
- County Annex Remodeling
- Jail Improvements – Project 1
- County Courthouse Remodeling

WHEREAS, the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners received materials at their March 22, 2001 Working Session providing them with an update on the status of the current County Space Plan Projects; and

WHEREAS, the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners also received materials at their March 22, 2001 Working Session providing them with a review of the physical condition of the County Court buildings and County Jail; and

WHEREAS, the review of the County Courts and County Jail revealed serious needs for alteration and improvement of these structures if they are to continue to serve the program and physical facility needs of the Washtenaw County Courts and County Jail; and

WHEREAS, the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners has on occasion directed the County Administrator to perform the planning and analysis necessary to update the County Space Plan; and

WHEREAS, it seems appropriate to commence the process of developing plans to address the needs of the County Courts and County Jail in January 2002.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby directs the County Administrator to commence the process of planning with the Board of Commissioners to meet the future program and physical facility needs of the Washtenaw County Courts and County Jail in January 2002.
