

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATOR TO PROCEED TO IDENTIFY A SINGLE SITE FOR THE WASHTENAW COUNTY HEAD START PROGRAM

WASHTENAW COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

May 16, 2001

WHEREAS, the Washtenaw County head Start Program provides direct service to participants within the Ypsilanti Public School District; and

WHEREAS, the program is dispersed over three sites which are currently leased; and

WHEREAS, the program service delivery sites include the Perry School (owned by Ypsilanti Public Schools) and the Jefferson Street site (owned by Shiloh Church of God); and

WHEREAS, the program administrative offices are located at 3075 Washtenaw Avenue (owned by Citizens Bank); and

WHEREAS, separation of the program over three sites inhibits efficient operation and service delivery; and

WHEREAS, a goal of the Head Start Program is to provide a comprehensive program housed at a single location.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the County Administrator to proceed to identify a single site for the Washtenaw County Head Start Program.
