

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING A REPRESENTATIVE TO THE WASHTENAW
COUNTY CONCEALED WEAPONS LICENSING BOARD FOR A TERM
EXPIRING DECEMBER 31, 2004

WASHTENAW COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

June 20, 2001

WHEREAS, Public Act 381 of 20002, the legislature made extensive changes to Michigan's concealed weapons licensing scheme MCL 28.421 et.seq.; and

WHEREAS, the amended Concealed Weapons Licensing Statute takes effective on July 1, 2001; and

WHEREAS, Section 5a(1)(a) of the new law allows the county prosecutor to withdraw from the board for the remainder of the prosecutor's elected term of office, and assume an advocacy role on applications for concealed weapons licenses; and

WHEREAS, in the event that the county prosecutor withdraws from the board, then the county board of commissioners shall appoint a replacement; and

WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney has notified the Chair of the Board his intent to assume the advocacy role created by section 5a(1)(a) of 2000 Public Act 381; and

WHEREAS, Section 5(1)(a) requires that the replacement be a firearms instructor who has the qualifications set forth in section 5j(1)(c) of the act; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby appoints the following individual to the Washtenaw County Concealed Weapons Licensing Board for the remainder of a term expiring December 31, 2004:
