

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE WASHTENAW COUNTY WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD FOR TERMS EXPIRING AS INDICATED

WASHTENAW COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

December 7, 2001

WHEREAS, on December 13, 1995, the Board of Commissioners adopted a resolution establishing the Washtenaw County Workforce Development Board; and

WHEREAS, due to changes in the state policy on Workforce Development Board representation, the education representatives must be elected, or appointed, board members of local educational agencies or local postsecondary educational institutions include area vocational schools; and

WHEREAS, due to this change, the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners transitioned the currently two education representatives to a category verbally recommended by the state, classified as "other" and appointed two education members that meet the new requirements (resolution 01-0225); and

WHEREAS, in addition, to meet the 51% private sector representation requirement, resolution 01-0225 created and appointed three additional private sector representatives; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 01-0287 modified the membership of the Workforce Development; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby appoints the following members to the Washtenaw County Workforce Development Board for the terms expiring as indicated:
