

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE WASHTENAW COUNTY WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD FOR THREE-YEAR TERMS EXPIRING AS INDICATED

WHEREAS, on December 13, 1995, the Board of Commissioners adopted a resolution establishing the Washtenaw County Workforce Development Board; and

WHEREAS, vacancies exist on the Workforce Development Board for areas representing private sector, organized labor/community based organization, and public assistance; and

WHEREAS, five vacancies exist for private sector representatives for three-year terms expiring December 31, 2005; and

WHEREAS, two vacancies exist for community based organizations for three-year terms expiring December 31, 2005; and

WHEREAS, one vacancy exists for an organized labor representative for a three-year term expiring December 31, 2005; and

WHEREAS, one vacancy exists for a rehabilitation representative for a three-year term expiring December 31, 2005; and

WHEREAS, one vacancy exists for a public assistance (FIA) representative for the remainder of a three-year term expiring December 31, 2004; and

WHEREAS, one vacancy exists for a private sector representative for the remainder of a three-year term expiring December 31, 2003
