

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING REPRESENTATION TO THE WASHTENAW COUNTY HOMELAND SECURITY TASK FORCE

WASHTENAW COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

November 17, 2004

WHEREAS, the Washtenaw County Homeland Security Task Force was created by the Board of Commissioners on August 6, 2003 under resolution #03-0138; and

WHEREAS, the Homeland Security Task Force was created to coordinate all county homeland security activities with federal, state and local governments; to assess terrorism risks, response capabilities and needed improvements; to develop community guidance and emergency response procedures; and to make recommendations to the Board of Commissioners about utilization of federal and state homeland security grant funds for domestic preparedness equipment and training; and

WHEREAS, the Homeland Security Task Force consists of representatives from various emergency response disciplines as recommended by the Department of Homeland Security for "Local Planning Teams" including two commissioner representatives, the Washtenaw County Sheriff, Director of Emergency Management, Public Health Officer, and several other key organizations; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security has added two areas of representation to their "Local Planning Team" recommendations, including Internet Security and Private Security, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Homeland Security has also announced plans to require these recommendations prior to awarding any future Homeland Security grants; and

RWHEREAS, resolution 04-0171 established these positions to the Homeland Security Task Force; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby appoints representation to the Homeland Security Task Force as follows:
