

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE 21<sup>ST</sup> CENTURY WORKFORCE: DEVELOPING COORDINATED REGIONAL STRATEGIES INITIATIVE FUNDING FROM THE MICHIGAN DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND ECONOMIC GROWTH IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000, FOR THE PERIOD OF AUGUST 1, 2006 THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2006 FOR THE EMPLOYMENT TRAINING AND COMMUNITY SERVICES GROUP; APPROVING THE BUDGET; AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN DELEGATE CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, ETCS serves employers and job seekers under State direction, through grants to local Michigan Works! Agencies, administered locally by the Washtenaw County Workforce Development Board; and

WHEREAS, ETCS has received notice that it will receive \$50,000 in funding from the Michigan Department of Labor (MDLEG) for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Workforce: Developing Coordinated Regional Strategies Initiative; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this funding is to enable the Michigan Works! Agencies (of which ETCS is one) to provide regional leadership in the development and/or strengthening of regional strategies to address both immediate and longer-term workforce needs of employers; and

WHEREAS, MDLEG staff has identified the Washtenaw County Michigan Works! Agency (MWA) and its Workforce Development Board (WDB) to serve as its own region for the purpose of this grant due to the existence of a new countywide partnership, MEGA-P; and

WHEREAS, the MEGA-P Agreement was established to focus on workforce and economic development issues that are critical to the mission of all partners and the citizens of Washtenaw County; and

WHEREAS, ETCS through the MEGA-P will have the responsibility to convene regional partners and facilitate the regional planning process; and

WHEREAS, this matter has been reviewed by the Workforce Development Board, Corporation Counsel, the Finance Department, the Human Resources Department, the County Administrator's Office, and the Ways and Means Committee;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby accepts the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Workforce: Developing Coordinated Regional Strategies Initiative funding from the Michigan Department of Labor and Economic Growth in the amount of \$50,000, for the period of August 1, 2006 through October 31, 2006 for the Employment Training and Community Services Group, as on file with the County Clerk

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners takes the following actions contingent upon receipt of the grant award:

1. Approving the budget as attached hereto and made a part hereof
2. Authorizing the County Administrator to sign the delegate contract upon review by Corporation Counsel, to be filed with the County Clerk
