

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE DEADLINE FOR YPSILANTI TOWNSHIP,
AUGUSTA TOWNSHIP AND SALEM TOWNSHIP TO ACCEPT OR REJECT
WASHTENAW COUNTY'S OPTIONS FOR CONTINUING POLICE SERVICES
AT THE CURRENT LEVEL

WASHTENAW COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

WHEREAS, on July 5, 2006, the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution #06-0149 which provided Ypsilanti Township, August Township and Salem Township with police service contract options they could exercise to continue contractual police services at the current levels being provided; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution gave the Townships until 9:00 a.m. on August 18, 2006 to notify the County whether they would accept one of, or reject the contract options; and

WHEREAS, the official certified copies of Resolution #06-0149, were inadvertently delayed before they were sent to the Townships; and

WHEREAS, because of this inadvertent delay, the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners now wishes to extend the deadline for the Townships to respond to Washtenaw County's contract options until 9:00 a.m. on Friday, September 1, 2006.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners extends the deadline for Ypsilanti Township, Augusta Township and Salem Township to respond to Washtenaw County's police service contract options as stated in Resolution #06-0149 from 9:00 a.m. on August 18, 2006 to 9:00 a.m. on September 1, 2006. All other provisions in Resolution #06-0149 remain in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners directs the County Administrator to immediately forward certified copies of this resolution to Ypsilanti Township, Augusta Township and Salem Township
