Maple Road and 2330-2390 Dexter Avenue, Ann Arbor, MI (Parcel ID Numbers 09-09-30-227-001, 09-09-19-310-024 and 09-09-30-260-004) located in the Washtenaw County redevelopment zone, subject to the local governmental unit approval.

The Hearing will be held on Wednesday, November 19, 2008, in the Board of Commissioner's Meeting Room, County Administration Building, 220 North Main Street, Ann Arbor, Michigan at 6:45 p.m.

All citizens of Washtenaw County have the right to be heard and shall have an opportunity to provide written and oral comments and to ask questions.
