

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING A WASHTENAW COUNTY REPRESENTATIVE TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MICHIGAN ASSOCIATION OF LOCAL PUBLIC HEALTH FOR THE REMAINDER OF A TWO YEAR TERM EXPIRING DECEMBER 31, 2009

WHEREAS, in 1985 an organization known as the Michigan Association of Local Health Department was established to represent the interests of public health at the community level to the Michigan legislature and the Michigan Department of Community Health; and

WHEREAS, Washtenaw County is entitled to two representatives to the Board of Directors, one of whom shall be the County Health Officer or his/her designee and an alternate, either a County Commissioner or a member of the Board of Health; and

WHEREAS, Barbara Bergman serves as the alternate; and

WHEREAS, Richard Fleece was appointed by the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners to be the Interim Health Officer to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Ellen Clement effective May1, 2009; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the County that the current Health Officer, Richard Fleece, be appointed to this Board during his tenure
