Board Action Requested:

Adoption of the resolution setting the 1998 Washtenaw County Millage Rate.

Background:

Each year, the millage rate to be used to levy the next year's property taxes is adopted by the Board of Commissioners. This total millage rate includes the Operating Millage, Drain Assessment, Parks and Huron-Clinton Metropolitan Authority taxes.

Discussion:

This resolution establishes the 1998 Washtenaw County Millage Rate at 5.4957. This figure is based on the 1998 Taxable Value and will be used to levy property taxes for the 1999 Fiscal Year.

The 1998 Millage Rate of 5.4957 is a reduction of .0006 mills from the 1997 Millage Rate of 5.4963.
