Board Action Requested:

The Employment Training Community Service (ETCS) Group is requesting the ratification of the Chair of the Board's signature on the FY 2001 Michigan Works! System Plan to the Michigan Department of Career Development for the period of July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2002.

Background:

With the rescission of the Job Training Partnership Act Master Plan and the Comprehensive Workforce Development Plan, it has become necessary to establish a document with applicable assurances, certifications, and stipulations for programs funded through the Office of Workforce Development (OWD). The Michigan Works! System Plan was devised for this specific function.

Discussion:

The ratification of the Chair of the Board's signature on the FY 2001 Michigan Works! System Plan will allow the Employment Training Community Service (ETCS) Group to participate in programs formerly covered under the Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA).
