SUBJECT: Annual Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Incumbent Worker

BOARD ACTION REQUESTED:

ETCS is requesting ratification of the Chairman of the Board's signature on the ETCS Fiscal Year 06-07 WIA Incumbent Worker Program Plan to the Michigan Department of Labor and Economic Growth in the amount of \$115,798 for the period of July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007.

BACKGROUND:

The Michigan Department of Labor and Economic Growth (MDCD) has identified \$3,000,000 in federal funds for the WIA Incumbent Worker Program. This program will address the goals of local strategic plans and the needs of local employers for a trained workforce.

DISCUSSION:

One of the five goals identified by the Washtenaw County Workforce Development Board (WDB) in their strategic planning process was to assist small and medium-sized businesses in developing their workforce needs. To qualify for funding, a business must have at least twenty-five (25) full-time employees. The Incumbent Worker Program will provide a solid tool in which to address this goal.

This funding will be used to provide employers in the Washtenaw County area with training services to upgrade existing employee skills in an effort to avoid layoff situations. Employers who benefit from this service will then work with the local Michigan Works! Service Center to fill any positions created by the promotion of incumbent workers who were trained through the program. Special emphasis will be placed on the hiring of both WIA and Work First Program participants and persons with disabilities.

The Washtenaw County WDB has formed a unique working partnership with both the Ann Arbor Chamber of Commerce and the Ypsilanti Chamber of Commerce. It is anticipated that both Chambers will generate the referrals of employers to benefit from this new program. The working partnership will consist of the WDB and the Chambers of Commerce sharing information on job seekers and employers to facilitate linkages between the organizations. The Chambers of Commerce will work actively to inform its members about the program and to encourage member participation. The WDB will assist the Chambers by communicating information about career opportunities in small and medium-sized businesses to its customers.

IMPACT ON HUMAN RESOURCES:

The requested Board action has no impact on Washtenaw County positions, personnel policies or procedures.

IMPACT ON BUDGET:

The requested Board action approves the FY 06-07 WIA Incumbent Worker Program budget in the amount of \$115,798.

IMPACT ON INDIRECT COSTS:

The requested board action has no indirect costs associated with this budget.

IMPACT ON OTHER COUNTY DEPARTMENTS OR OUTSIDE AGENCIES:

The requested Board action has no impact on other County Departments or outside agencies.
