SUBJECT: 2009-10 Head Start Grant Application

BOARD ACTION REQUESTED:

The Washtenaw County Head Start program is requesting that the Board of Commissioners authorize the Chair of the Board of Commissioners to sign the application to the Department of Health and Human Services for the Head Start Program for the period of August 1, 2009 through July 31, 2010 in the amount of \$4,821,046 (for the base grant, oral health grant, and training and technical assistance). It is further requested that the Board of Commissioners authorize the Administrator to sign the notice of grant award, approve the 2009-10 Head Start budget authorize the Administrator to sign the delegate contracts.

BACKGROUND:

Washtenaw County has administered the Head Start program, a Program of Excellence, for eligible children and their families in Washtenaw County for forty-four (44) years, and currently directly operates a program in Ypsilanti, and has Child Care Partnerships for 262 children and families. Ann Arbor, Whitmore Lake, and Willow Run Head Start services are delegated to the school district for 299 children and families.

DISCUSSION:

Authorization of the signature of the Chair of the Board of Commissioners on the 2009-10 Head Start grant application and approval of the budget will allow continued preschool services to children between the ages of 3 and 5 and their families who meet the eligibility criteria for the Head Start Program. The Head Start Program is a comprehensive, two-generational child development program geared toward breaking the cycle of poverty through educational, health, nutrition, social, emotional and cognitive services, and has recently been named a National Program of Excellence.

Washtenaw County Head Start continually works to ensure comparable wages to staff throughout the grantee. Wages have been negotiated through a collective bargaining process.

A total of \$1,421,843 will be delegated to the following:

*Ann Arbor Public Schools will receive \$749,875
Ann Arbor Public Schools will serve 154 children

*Whitmore Lake Public Schools will receive \$180,292
Whitmore Lake Public Schools will serve 43 children

*Willow Run Community Schools will receive \$453,340
Willow Run Community Schools will serve 102 children

The Grantee will serve 262 children either directly or through Child Care Partnerships and administer the countywide program using \$2,112,174 of the Federal funding.

An additional amount of \$43,876 will be utilized by the entire program for training and technical assistance.

Impact on Human Resources:

There will be no impact on Human Resources.

Impact on Budget:

The requested Board action will approve the Washtenaw County Head Start Grant budget in the amount of \$4,821,046. This amount includes \$3,539,557 Federal funding; \$867,565 local match contribution from the County (to be included in the 2010 general fund budget); and \$413,924 in-kind match from delegates and the

grantee. The 2009-10 grant application reflects a reduction of \$37,500 in federal Head Start revenue due to the expiration of the Oral Health grant initiative, which was originally funded for the period of January 2006 to January 2010.

In addition to the grant application budget of \$4,821,046, the budget amendment attached to the resolution includes the planned expenditures and related USDA reimbursement revenue for the food program. The total amount of USDA revenue and expenditures is budgeted at \$140,324 bringing the resolution budget to a total of \$4,961,400.

IMPACT ON INDIRECT COSTS:

The grant application includes \$167,974 for the Cost Allocation Plan.

IMPACT ON OTHER COUNTY DEPARTMENTS OR OUTSIDE AGENCIES:

This action reflects the ongoing community collaboration with Ann Arbor Public Schools, Whitmore Lake Public Schools, Willow Run Public Schools, and Child Care Partners.

CONFORMITY TO COUNTY POLICIES:

The requested Board action is in conformity with County policies.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO SIGN THE APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR THE HEAD START PROGRAM, A PROGRAM OF EXCELLENCE, FOR THE PERIOD OF AUGUST 1, 2009 THROUGH JULY 31, 2010 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,821,046; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN THE NOTICE OF GRANT AWARD; APPROVING THE 2009-2010 HEAD START BUDGET; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN DELEGATE CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, Washtenaw County has administered the Head Start program, a Program of Excellence, for eligible children and their families in Washtenaw County for forty-three (43) years; and

WHEREAS, the Head Start program serves 561 children of which 262 will be served by Washtenaw County either directly or through child care partnerships and 299 through three delegate programs; and

WHEREAS, 2009-2010 is the second year in the three-year grant cycle 2008-2011; and

WHEREAS, the Head Start Management Team will ensure compliance with all regulations; and

WHEREAS, the federal grant of \$3,539,557 will be used for child development, health, training and technical assistance and family services; and

WHEREAS, required local match will be provided by the County General Fund in the amount of \$867,565 as well as \$413,924 in-kind contributions from Head Start parents, delegates and community volunteers; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the Federal grant application, expenditures for the food program are projected to be reimbursed by the U.S. Department of Agriculture in the amount of \$140,354; and

WHEREAS, this matter has been reviewed and approved by the Head Start Policy Council, the County Administrator's Office, Corporation Counsel, the Office of Finance, Human Resources, and the Ways and Means Committee.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Commissioners to sign the application to the Department of Health and Human Services for the Head Start Program, a Program of Excellence, for the period of August 1, 2009 through July 31, 2010 in the amount of \$4,821,046 to be filed with the County Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners takes the following actions contingent upon receipt of the grant award in conformity with the application:

1. Authorizing the Chair of the Board of Commissioners to sign the application to the Department of Health and Human Services for the Head Start program
2. Authorizing the County Administrator to sign the Notice of Grant Award
3. Amending the budget, as attached hereto and made a part hereof
4. Authorizing the County Administrator to sign the delegate contracts upon review of Corporation Counsel, to be filed with the County Clerk.
