The Washtenaw County Michigan Works! These funds will be used to provide training and/or support services to customers currently enrolled in WIA Adult, Dislocated Worker and/or Youth programs and/or for any other activity authorized under WIA Title 1B.

- Supportive Services to Obtain & Maintain Employment (transportation, interview/work related clothing, skill development...)

- Individual and Group Career Counseling
- Mentoring
- Follow-up

Participants served through these Incentive funds will be educated in all of their options as WIA participants. Staff will work with each individual participant to address their job search, training and occupational needs.
