WHEREAS, the Office of Strategic Planning submitted a grant application to the State of Michigan Historic Preservation Grant Program for funding the Chelsea Center for the Arts Rehabilitation Master Plan and National Register Nomination in the amount of \$22,000; and

WHEREAS, the State of Michigan Historic Preservation Grant Program requires a \$14,994.35 match, \$14,761.85 of which will be provided in-kind by the Office of Strategic Planning and the Chelsea Center for the Arts; and

WHEREAS, the remaining cash match of \$232.50 will be absorbed within the Office of Strategic Planning's 2009 General Fund budget; and

WHEREAS, in February 1986 Washtenaw County received a Certified Local Government Agreement from the Michigan Bureau of History; and

WHEREAS, on April 16, 1986, the Board of Commissioners approved by Resolution 86-0215 an application for Certification of Local Government under the National Historic Preservation Act Amendments of 1980 and the Michigan Bureau of History Guidelines of April 5, 1985; and

WHEREAS, Washtenaw County is a Certified Local Government eligible to apply for Michigan Historic Preservation Fund for grant dollars to strengthen and augment the County's Historic Preservation Program; and

WHERAS, the County Historic District Commission endorses the application for this grant as presented to them; and

WHEREAS, the funding of this grant will be used to create a Rehabilitation Master Plan and National Register Nomination for the Chelsea Center for the Arts, located in the former St. Mary's Parish School in Chelsea, Michigan; and

WHEREAS, the County Historic District Commission will receive reports on the progress of the workshop series on a periodic basis; and

WHEREAS, this matter has been reviewed by Corporation Counsel, the Finance Department, the County Administrator's Office, and the Ways and Means Committee.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby ratifies the signature of the County Administrator on the application to the State of Michigan Historic Preservation Certified Local Government Grant Program for the Chelsea Center of the Arts Rehabilitation Master Plan and National Register Nomination in the amount of \$22,000.00 for a total program amount of \$36,994.35, as on file with the County Clerk.

WHEREAS, ETCS submitted a plan to the Michigan Department of Energy, Labor, and Economic Growth for the WIA National Emergency Grant (NEG) in the amount of \$138,606 for the period of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the federal Workforce Investment Act (WIA) was implemented in 1998 to address workforce development and employment training to meet the needs of businesses, job seekers and those who want to further their careers; and

WHEREAS, the WIA is the primary funding source for Governor Granholm's No Worker Left Behind (NWLB) initiative announced in August 2007, an ambitious plan to train 100,000 citizens in three (3) years for jobs in high demand occupations and emerging industries or entrepreneurial endeavors; and

WHEREAS, ETCS is the administrator and operator of workforce development programs in Washtenaw County and is funded by the Workforce Investment Act (WIA), the United States Department of Labor (USDOL), and the Michigan Department of Labor and Economic Growth (MDLEG) to provide employment training and placement services; and

WHEREAS, the Washtenaw County Workforce Development Board (WDB) and the Board of Commissioners oversee, recommend and approve employment and training programs throughout Washtenaw County delivered by the ETCS, also referred to as the local Michigan Works! Agency (MWA); and

WHEREAS, Michigan requested of the United States Department of Labor (USDOL) and received, a National Emergency Grant (NEG) in the amount up to \$6.6 million, which includes an original release of funding of \$2,475,000; and

WHEREAS, the NEG awarded to Michigan is to provide workers dislocated as a result of statewide layoffs in the automotive industry a full array of dislocated worker services that may include skills assessment, individual career counseling, career and occupational skills training.; and

WHEREAS, targeted participants will be those individuals who are dislocated from the auto industry and individuals whose communities have been impacted by the restructuring of the auto industry; and

WHEREAS, the project service design will be based on placing participants in unsubsidized employment as quickly as possible; and WHEREAS, the major activity each dislocated worker will utilize through the program will be retraining focused on high-growth, high-demand occupations; and

WHEREAS, this matter has been reviewed by the Washtenaw County Workforce Development Board (WDB), Corporation's Counsel, the Finance Department, Human Resources, the County Administrator's Office, and the Ways and Means Committee.

# **BACKGROUND**

The City of Ann Arbor (City) submitted an amended City of Ann Arbor Master Plan Land Use Element on January 27, 2009, for comment by Washtenaw County, in accordance with the procedures set forth in the Michigan Planning Enabling Act, Public Act 33 of 2008. The Act requires the County to provide comments, which are advisory only, to the City. The comments must include, but need not be limited to, both of the following as applicable:

- A statement as to whether the proposed master plan is consistent with the plans of contiguous communities and applicable regional plans, and;
- A statement as to whether the proposed update is consistent with the County Plan.

#### DISCUSSION

Office of Strategic Planning staff evaluated the proposed amendments according to the goals, objectives and recommendations of *A Comprehensive Plan for Washtenaw County*. The Office of Strategic Planning distributed the amendments to the Washtenaw County Departments of Public Works, Parks and Recreation, Public Health, Washtenaw County Road Commission, Office of the Water Resources Commissioner and the Washtenaw Area Transportation Study (WATS) for comment. Any comments received from these departments and agencies are included in the attached staff report.

The attached comments and staff report were reviewed and approved by the Washtenaw County Planning Advisory Board at their February 23, 2009 meeting. After acceptance of the report by the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners, the report will be submitted to the City and the contiguous communities.
