WHEREAS, Washtenaw County has been the grantee for this NAEYC Accredited Head Start Program of Excellence, which addresses literacy of preschoolers and their families; and

WHEREAS, The Washtenaw County Head Start Program has collaborated with The Ann Arbor Links, Inc., Success By Six and The Literacy Coalition of Washtenaw County to launch The Imagination Library for children 0-5, to positively address literacy; and

WHEREAS, The Imagination Library is a free program for young children, in which each month a new, carefully selected book is mailed directly to the registered children; and

WHEREAS, children develop much of their capacity to learn in the first three years of life and The Imagination Library will positively impact their opportunities to learn,; and

WHEREAS, Kindergarten teachers have affirmed that children who participate in The Imagination Library "were better prepared...and exceeded teacher expectations".

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners proclaims April 2010 as The Month of the Young Child, in which community collaborators including Head Start, The Links, Success by Six and The Literacy Coalition of Washtenaw County have struck a blow to illiteracy by launching The Imagination Library for young children and stepping forward on "The Blueprint to End Illiteracy" in Washtenaw County.

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE LITERACY COALITION  
OF WASHTENAW COUNTY AS A COMMUNITY LED COALITION

WASHTENAW COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

APRIL 7, 2010

WHEREAS, literacy is a foundational cornerstone of success for every aspect of life, and yet an estimated 27,000 adults in Washtenaw County struggle with basic literacy skills; and

WHEREAS, under the leadership of Commissioners Ronnie Peterson and Leah Gunn, Washtenaw County Administration convened a small working group of stakeholders and community leaders in the fall of 2006 to evaluate the growing problem of illiteracy; and

WHEREAS, in order to give this working group the legitimacy and stature required to address such a serious problem, the Board of Commissioners created a Literacy Coalition in July 2007; and

WHEREAS, the Coalition is comprised of members from a variety of sectors, including academia, government, not-for-profit, libraries, faith-based organizations, and businesses; and

WHEREAS, the Coalition evolved from a fragmented group of single service providers operating independently to a coordinated partnership of service delivery across programs and funding streams; and

WHEREAS, the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners accepted and endorsed the Literacy Coalition of Washtenaw County's "Blueprint to End Illiteracy" in Washtenaw County in March 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Coalition held a community awareness event with Stedman Graham to address the importance of breaking the cycle of illiteracy as a means to break the cycle of poverty in March 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Coalition developed a pilot project, Learning Is A Family Thing (LIFT), serving over 400 individuals within Washtenaw County; and

WHEREAS, the Coalition secured grants for planning and for the first two years of implementation; and

WHEREAS, the Coalition created a grant funded full-time Literacy Coordinator position in October 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Coalition established an organizational structure in October 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Coalition is committed to uniting the community around a vision of 100% literacy through 100% community engagement;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby recognizes the Literacy Coalition of Washtenaw County as a Community Led Coalition:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby charges the Literacy Coalition of Washtenaw County with the implementation of the “Blueprint to End Illiteracy” in Washtenaw County:

WASHTENAW COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

April 7, 2010

WHEREAS, the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners and the Regents of the University of Michigan have approved the creation of a Washtenaw Community Health Organization (99-0154); and

WHEREAS, the Washtenaw Community Health Organization Board was established to provide an integrated health care delivery system to provide mental health, substance abuse and primary and specialty health care to Medicaid, low income and indigent consumers as defined by the Mental Health Code and Medicaid Eligibility Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with the Urban Cooperation Act, MCLA 124,501, the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners and the Regents of the University of Michigan shall appoint a 12 member Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, each agency shall appoint at least one primary and one secondary consumer to this board; and

WHEREAS, a primary consumer is an individual who has received or is receiving services from the Department of Community Health or a community health services program or services from the private sector equivalent to those offered by the Department of Community Health or a Community Mental Health Program; and

WHEREAS, a secondary consumer is the family member of an individual receiving services from either Washtenaw County or the University of Michigan; and

WHEREAS, two vacancies exist representing the county for terms expiring March 31, 2013; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby appoints the following members to the Washtenaw Community Health Organization Board for terms expiring as follows:

**BOARD ACTION REQUESTED:**

It is requested that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners consider approval of the attached Resolution, calling for a Public Hearing to be held before the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners on May 5, 2010. The Public Hearing, as stipulated by State of Michigan law, will serve as the mechanism for citizens and taxing jurisdictions to provide comment on the proposed Amendment to the Washtenaw County Brownfield Plan for the Saline Automotive Components Holdings, LLC Brownfield Redevelopment Plan, prior to the Board of Commissioners consideration of its approval.

**BACKGROUND:**

In May of 1999, the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners established the Washtenaw County Brownfield Redevelopment Authority (WCBRA) through Resolution 99-0110, and subsequently appointed members to its Board the same year (Res. 99-0122). In October of 2000, Commissioners adopted the Brownfield Redevelopment Plan (Plan) for Washtenaw County. All subsequent projects are Amendments to this Plan and require consideration of approval by the BOC. On May 17, 1999, the City of Saline joined the WCBRA as a municipal member, by adoption of a resolution.

Pursuant to the State of Michigan Brownfield Redevelopment Financing Act (P.A. 381 of 1996, as amended), the WCBRA is preparing an Amendment to the Washtenaw County Brownfield Plan for the Saline Automotive Components Holdings, LLC Brownfield Redevelopment Plan to be eligible for Michigan Business Tax Credits (MBT) on the project located within the brownfield redevelopment zone. The Amendment must be

submitted to the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners for adoption. Prior to that adoption, the law stipulates that a Public Hearing be held.

**DISCUSSION:**

The Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners has demonstrated its support for the sustainable redevelopment of environmentally distressed sites in Washtenaw County. By establishing and supporting the Brownfield Redevelopment Authority and its Board, the Commissioners have begun the process to transform underutilized brownfields into productive properties. Calling for a Public Hearing on the Amendment to the Washtenaw County Brownfield Plan will assist in moving the Authority towards fulfilling its purpose as required by Public Act 381.

The Saline Automotive Components Holdings, LLC project will provide economic assistance to support the continued economic viability and growth of a large manufacturing facility in the City of Saline. This Amendment is to enable MBT Credit application to the State of Michigan Treasury Department for approximately \$1.2 Million in MBT credits. Other brownfield eligible activities related will be addressed through private financing.
