RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

An adjourned session of the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners was held at the Administration Building, in the City of Ann Arbor, Michigan, on Wednesday, October 20, 2010.

The meeting was called to order at 8:01 p.m. by Rolland Sizemore, Jr., Chair of the Board.

Pledge of Allegiance

Approval of the Minutes of the Previous Meeting

Comm. Gunn seconded by Comm. Irwin moved that the minutes of the October 6, 2010, meeting of the Board of Commissioners be approved. Motion carried.

Citizen Participation

Wyckham Seelig, 2708 Aspen Ct., Lodi Township, stated that he would like to quote from James Madison, Federalist Papers No. 10 and other historic texts. He stated that there are dangers in single party rule. He added that the attacks on Comm. Ouimet are examples. Seelig stated that it is Chicago politics at its best. He added that he is talking about Comm. Judge and Clerk Kestenbaum. Seelig stated that standards are being applied retroactively. He added that silence on this matter gives tacit consent. He added that this is normal and ordinary behavior in a jurisdiction without political competition.

Mark Boonstra, 8793 Webster Hills Rd., Webster Township, Chair, Washtenaw County Republican Party, stated that he is attending on behalf of Mark Ouimet. He stated that Ouimet was elected Vice Chair and was relied on to help solve budget issues. Boonstra stated that Comm. Ouimet does not charge for out of county travel. He stated that Comm. Judge has moved to transfer travel dollars from another commissioner. Boonstra stated that the democrats have done the mudslinging this year. He stated that he would like an independent audit to be conducted for all commissioners.

Paul Schissler, 12950 Trinkle Rd., Lima Township, stated that he has lived here most of his life. He added that there are politicians that do the job for a living. He stated that Comm. Ouimet went to lots of meetings. Schissler stated that Comm. Ouimet donates his entire salary every year. He added that the number of commissioners that keep their salary and the number of meetings were not mentioned in a recent article in AnnArbor.com. Schissler stated that Comm. Ouimet is one of the best people he has known. He added that he pays attention to public servants that do a good job donating service and time.

Lawrence Kestenbaum, Washtenaw County Clerk/Register of Deeds, stated that he considers all around the table to be friends. He added that the report from his office is not considered an attack. Kestenbaum stated that he had no hand in deciding the eligibility of meetings. He reported that the same standard in the report was applied to meetings from past years. Kestenbaum added that this report was requested of his office. He added that he does not support per diems for commissioners on the Board. He added that good people can be slurred by past records.

Commissioner Follow-Up to Citizen Participation

Comm. Prater stated that he believes that Kestenbaum's statements are factual. He added that he feels that Mr. Boonstra's statements are incorrect. Comm. Prater stated that he is not accusing anyone of anything inappropriate.

Comm. Judge distributed BOC spending 2005-2010 and Compensation (Salary and Benefits) Direct Financial Benefit to Commissioner (on file in County Clerk's office). Comm. Judge read from the Compensatory Service section of the Board rules. She stated that the Board is in charge of spending and stated that Board spending is the most important thing to watch. She added that this is a matter of following Board rules. She stated that this is a problem that led to thousands of dollars of spending. Comm. Judge stated that she does not have the power to bully the County Clerk. She added that she brought back tangibles from travel and conferences she attended. Comm. Judge stated that she is not a minion for Mark Brewer. She added that per diems are choices that commissioners make.

Comm. Gunn stated that she is not a member of the party that approves of everything the party does. She added that that accusing elected officials of a plot is not fair. She stated that she has always found Mark Ouimet to be honorable and gracious.

Comm. Schwartz stated that he feels that Lansing politics is being brought to Washtenaw County. He added that this board is bipartisan because the it works together to solve problems. Comm. Sizemore stated that he does not appreciate this coming forward and added that he also feels that it is coming from Lansing.

Comm. Ouimet stated that this has been an interesting process. He added that he felt the Board stepped up into a leadership role. Comm. Ouimet stated that he has been presented with numbers and would stand by what he says and would challenge any other member to do the same. Comm. Ouimet added that he would be willing to put the money into an escrow account pending a further discussion.

Comm. Bergman stated that it has been a privilege to work with all members. She added that this Board votes together on most issues and added that disagreements are not Democrat and Republican. Comm. Bergman stated that collaborative funding was looked at to benefit all residents.

Comm. Judge stated that she appreciates that the Board has worked as a team. She added that the flex spending account has cut spending by about 46%. Comm. Judge stated that in the past she has been accused of micromanaging.

WHEREAS, ETCS The requested CSBG-D grant funds will be used to conduct a Needs Assessment of the Gateway/South Side of Ypsilanti Neighborhood, securing input from neighborhood residents, community stakeholders and considering the results of prior assessments; and
