RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

An adjourned session of the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners was held at the Administration Building, in the City of Ann Arbor, Michigan, on Wednesday, October 6, 2010.

The meeting was called to order at 8:01 p.m. by Rolland Sizemore, Jr., Chair of the Board.

Comm. Prater reported on the Road Commission. He stated that the Road Commission has about \$100 million in bridge and road repairs captured in its CIP. Comm. Prater added that there is no funding source for all of these improvements.

Comm. Bergman reported on the Human Services Collaborative Council. She stated that the HSCC has been able to do publicity on the fact that infant mortality in the African-American community is three times higher than it is in the Caucasian community and added that this should not be happening. Comm. Bergman also reported on the Michigan Re-Entry Program. She stated that the HIV-AIDS Statewide Coalition has been reduced to two staff members but is still getting things done including providing inoculations against Hepatitis A and B. .

Comm. Sizemore stated that Patricia Denig and staff did a great job with a recent conference he attended. He stated that the Firehouse Museum was excellent. Comm. Sizemore added that he would like to thank Comm. Prater and Comm. Judge for putting the CVS discount drug card in place.

Special Order of Business:

Public hearing to receive public comments on a proposed tax millage of 0.043 of a mill pursuant to Public Act 88 of 1913 (MCLA 46.161) to promote the agricultural, industrial and tourist advantages of Washtenaw County

Jennifer Fike, Food System Economic Partnership, stated that she is speaking on behalf of Sharon Sheldon, FSEP Leadership Team. She reported that Sheldon is indicating that she would like to see continued support.

Ken Siler, 13175 East Pleasant Lake Rd., Freedom Township, Washtenaw County Farm Bureau, stated that he would not like the County to levy this tax without approval of the homeowner. He stated that he would like the Board to cast an unfavorable vote on the Act 88 millage and added that the Farm Bureau is against this millage.

Sara Aeschbach, AAPS, stated that she is in support of FSEP. She stated that the program has been expanded in the last four years. Aeschbach added that food was served three times/week in local school cafeterias.

John Oahs, 3400 Haab Rd., Freedom Township stated that farming and agriculture has always been a centerpiece in his life. He added that he opposes the use of Public Act 88 funds should not be used. Oahs stated that homeowners must approve any tax. He added that farmers have always paid a disproportionate number amount of income taxes.

David Clingberger, 612 Brooks St., Ann Arbor City, stated that he is speaking on behalf of FSEP. He added that he would not be in business if it was not for the support of FSEP.

Elizabeth Parkinson, Ann Arbor SPARK, stated that she would like to thank the Board for their support. She stated that funding this year came from Act 88 rather than the County general fund. Parkinson reported that there have been impressive economic development results in the last six months. She added that SPARK East is the incubator on the east side of the County. Parkinson added that an additional \$1 million was leveraged from funds provided.

Joe Harding, Co-Founder, Current Motor Company, stated that his company has taken advantage of several of the initiatives from SPARK. He added that his company makes electric motorcycles and scooters.

Mitch Rohde, Quantum Signal, stated that he would like to talk about the benefits of Ann Arbor SPARK. He stated that SPARK provided assistance in headquarter location, recruitment, and information on tax incentives. He stated that jobs are being created directly because of their help.

A RESOLUTION OF APPRECIATION TO MARK R. LINDKE FOR THIRTY-SEVEN PLUS YEARS OF SERVICE TO WASHTENAW COUNTY

WHEREAS, Mark R. Lindke began his career with Washtenaw County over 37 years ago, beginning as a Veteran Benefits Counselor in the County Veteran Services Office, then a Senior Veteran Benefits Counselor, and then a Senior Veteran Benefits Specialist. Mark held the position of Senior Veteran Benefits Specialist until November of 1996 when he was appointed Director of Washtenaw County Veteran Services; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Lindke, during his career as the Director of Washtenaw County Veteran Services, brought the department into the modern age of leadership, technology, and employee development with his tireless adherence to the Business Improvement Process; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Lindke was instrumental in obtaining software to automate the processing of claims for veterans, their survivors and dependents and continued to search for better products to increase efficiency and effectiveness in the processing of claims for the veteran community of Washtenaw County; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Lindke ensured all employees in the office obtained accreditation with the Department of Veterans Affairs to present claims on behalf of beneficiaries, and makes certain employees receive the appropriate annual recertification training required to maintain accreditation, as well as participate in other professional development courses available to employees; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Lindke took the lead in the State of Michigan to obtain remote access to the Department of Veterans Affairs computing systems for all employees to better case manage claims represented by the accredited County Veteran Service Officers in the department. For many years, Washtenaw County was one of only two counties in the state that had remote access. Mr. Lindke worked tirelessly to educate counterparts in other counties and recently, more counties have followed the lead of Mr. Lindke to work with the Department of Veterans Affairs to get remote access for their counties; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Lindke is a well-known and respected leader in the Washtenaw County veteran community, as well as in the State of Michigan and on a national level. Mr. Lindke served as the Alternate Delegate from the State of Michigan for the National Association of County Veteran Service Officers and served on the executive committee of that organization. Mr. Lindke also served as the President of the Michigan Association of County Veterans Counselors; an

WHEREAS, Mr. Lindke is totally committed to public service as a noble, dignified, and worthy career and champions the causes of his public in a way that should be emulated

by those others working in the area of veteran law and any other area of public service;
and

WHEREAS, Mr. Lindke is the epitome of a servant-leader who uses his calm, steady, and patient approach to manage and lead in a way that motivates and inspires employees to go the extra “two miles” for their clients; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Lindke was instrumental in reorganizing the office under PA 192 of 1953 and working with Administration and the Board of Commissioners to levy the required millage for the Veterans Relief Fund per PA 214, which brought the County into compliance with those statutes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Washtenaw County Board of Commissioners hereby extends its heartfelt appreciation to Mark R. Lindke for his thirty-seven (37) plus years of service to the Washtenaw County Department of Veterans Affairs and wishes him continued success in his future endeavors.

RESOLUTION DECLARING OCTOBER 2010 AS
NATIONAL CYBER SECURITY AWARENESS MONTH

WASHTENAW COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OCTOBER 6, 2010

WHEREAS, citizens, schools, libraries, businesses and other organizations use the Internet for a variety of tasks, including keeping in contact with family and friends, managing personal finances, performing research, enhancing education and conducting business; and

WHEREAS, critical sectors are increasingly reliant on information systems to support financial services, energy, telecommunications, transportation, utilities, health care, and emergency response systems; and

WHEREAS, Internet users and our information infrastructure face an increasing threat of malicious cyber attack, loss of privacy from spyware and adware and significant financial and personal privacy losses due to identity theft and fraud; and

WHEREAS, maintaining the security of cyberspace is a shared responsibility in which each of us has a critical role, and awareness of computer security essentials will improve the security of Washtenaw County's information infrastructure and economy; and

WHEREAS, National Cyber Security Awareness Month is meant to make citizens keenly aware of the risks and vulnerabilities of being online and to empower them to securely use the internet; and

WHEREAS, the Multi-State Information Sharing and Analysis Center was established in January 2003 to provide a collaborative mechanism to help states and local governments enhance cyber security; and the Michigan Department of Information Technology provides a comprehensive approach to help enhance the security of this government; and

WHEREAS, in 1991 Washtenaw County, the Townships of Bridgewater, Dexter, Lima, Lyndon, Manchester and Sylvan, the Village of Manchester and the City of Chelsea (the "Municipalities") and the Western Washtenaw Recycling Authority (the "Authority") cooperated pursuant to Public Act 185 in the establishment of a Resource Recycling Project to serve the municipalities; and

WHEREAS, there has been submitted to this Board resolutions adopted by the Governing Boards of the Townships of Bridgewater, Dexter, Lima, Lyndon, and the City of Chelsea located in Washtenaw County (the "Townships") requesting the County of Washtenaw (the "County") acting through its Department of Public Works, to undertake a project to construct an expansion of the existing Resource Recovery Facility located in Lyndon Township; and

WHEREAS, resolutions from additional municipalities are expected to be submitted in the future; and

WHEREAS, the County will conduct its necessary review of this project under the County's Full Faith and Credit Policy and the various County departments and officials are expected to submit a positive recommendation; and

WHEREAS, it appears to this Board that the establishment and construction of the Project, as requested by the Municipalities, is feasible and should be carried out subject to the final Full Faith and Credit review and execution of a contract between the County and the Municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the Project would be established through the issuance of County bonds, financed pursuant to the provisions of Act No. 185, Michigan Public Acts of 1957, as amended ("Act 185"); and

WHEREAS, in order to comply with the request, it is necessary that the Project be approved by resolution adopted by the County Board of Commissioners, pursuant to Act 185.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The Board of Commissioners does hereby preliminarily approve, pursuant to Act 185 and subject to the final Full Faith and Credit Policy review and the execution of a contract between the County and the Municipalities, the constructing of a Resource Recovery Project for the Municipalities.
2. The Project shall be known as the "Western Washtenaw Recycling Project".
3. The County shall pledge its full faith and credit to the payment of the principal of and interest on any bonds or notes of the County issued for the Project.
4. The firm of Axe & Ecklund, P.C. attorneys of Grosse Pointe Farms, Michigan, is hereby designated as bond counsel in connection with the Project, and the firm of Public Financial Management of Ann Arbor, Michigan, is hereby designated as financial consultants for the County in connection with the Project.
5. The issuance and sale of Bonds in the amount of not to exceed \$2,800,000 shall be subject to the approval of the Michigan Department of Treasury, as required by law, and the Director of the Department of Public Works, or Bond Counsel is hereby authorized to make application to the Department of Treasury for permission to issue and sell Bonds. Alternatively, the Director of the Department of Public Works, or Bond Counsel, in his or her discretion, is authorized to apply for an exception to such prior approval from the Michigan Department of Treasury.

At the regularly scheduled Homeland Security Task Force meeting on May 25, 2010, a resolution was adopted by unanimous vote to add one representative from the University of Michigan and one representative from Eastern Michigan University to improve communications, coordination, cooperation and resource sharing with the Homeland Security Task Force. These representatives would be appointed by an executive officer (University President or Vice President) and serve at the will of the appointing institution.
