#### Emergency Management – Annual Emergency Management Performance Grant

Comm. Yekulis seconded by Comm. DuRussel moved to recommend that the Board of Commissioners approve the resolution authorizing the Chair of the Board to sign an Emergency Management Work Agreement; authorizing the County Administrator to sign an Emergency Management Performance Grant request; and authorizing the Administrator to sign the agreement with the State of Michigan contingent upon its receipt in conformity with the application.

Marc Breckenridge, Emergency Management Director, answered questions.

### **Environment & Infrastructure Services – Environmental Services Activities**

Comm. Yekulis seconded by Comm. DuRussel moved to recommend that the Board of Commissioners approve the resolution, at the Board Meeting tonight, authorizing the signature of the Washtenaw County Administrator on the contract between the State of Michigan Department of Environmental Quality and the Washtenaw County Department of Environment and Infrastructure Services for the period October 1, 2000, through September 30, 2001, in the amount of \$509,662 for Environmental Health Programs.

Dick Fleece, Environmental Services Department, answered questions.

### **Planning – Historic Preservation Grant Program**

Comm. Yekulis seconded by Comm. DuRussel moved to recommend that the Board of Commissioners approve the resolution authorizing the signature of the County Administrator on the application to the State of Michigan Historic Preservation Grant Program for the City of Milan for restoration of the Hack House Museum in the amount of \$28,920 for a total program amount of \$48,200.

Mark McFadden, Planning Director, answered questions.

### **Planning – Ypsilanti Gateway Community & Economic Development Corporation – Housing Affordability Agreement**

Comm. Yekulis seconded by Comm. DuRussel moved to recommend that the Board of Commissioners approve the resolution authorizing the Administrator to sign the Affordable Housing Agreement with Ypsilanti Gateway Community and Economic Development Corporation for a recoverable grant for purchase of two vacant lots (Lots 83 and 84) on Orchard Street in Ypsilanti in the amount of \$10,500 for a total project cost of 21,000.

Mark Roby and Lefiest Galimore answered questions. Following some discussion, Curtis Hedger, Corporation Counsel, agreed to bring back a report to the Board on how we could prevent a second buyer from selling at a higher price.

### **Planning – Ypsilanti Gateway Community & Economic Development Corporation – Housing Affordability Agreement**

Comm. Shaw seconded by Comm. Chockley moved to recommend that the Board of Commissioners approve the resolution authorizing the Administrator to sign the Affordable Housing Agreement with Ypsilanti Gateway Community and Economic Development Corporation for a recoverable grant for purchase of four vacant lots (Lots 53, 54, 81 & 82) on Worden and Orchard Streets in Ypsilanti in the amount of \$10,000 each for a total project cost of \$40,000.

Mr. Guenzel announced that the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has approved the County's HOME Consortium application in conjunction with Ypsilanti and Ypsilanti Township.
