Trial Court – Community Corrections

Comm. DuRussel seconded by Comm. Gunn moved to recommend that the Board of Commissioners approve the resolution amending the 2000/2001 Fiscal Year Budget for the remaining three quarters of the community Corrections Comprehensive Program, authorizing the creation and elimination of positions, and authorizing the discontinuation of the FY 200/01 Zero Abuse Pretrial Program (ZAPP) Evaluation Grant.

Sheriff – Sheriff’s Department Administration Realignment

Comm. DuRussel seconded by Comm. Gunn moved to recommend that the Board of Commissioners approve the resolution authorizing the reorganization of the Sheriff’s Department Management Team, including the creation and elimination of positions, and instep hiring to improve service to both the department and community effective January 1, 2001.

Daniel Minzey explained the proposed reorganization and answered questions. He indicated there was one change he was making and that was to put Anderson Brown in the Police Services Commander.
