Citizen Participation

Chris Smail, 8857 Pleasantview Dr., Northville, stated that he is opposed to using tax dollars to fund Planned Parenthood services.

Chris Kanta, 10430 Noggles, Manchester, spoke on behalf of the Community Resource Center in Manchester. She discussed services provided by her organization. She added that she feels that the Manchester Area has not received similar services to other areas due to location. Kanta stated that her organization was denied funding by the County, and added that she did not recognize that any organization on the western side of the County has been funded.

Commissioner Follow-Up to Citizens' Participation

Comm. Ping Mills thanked Chris Kanta, and stated that she agrees, and stated that she feels that the Funders Forum needs to be made up of a more diverse cross section of the County.

Comm. Lovejoy Roe discussed Planned Parenthood funding. She reported on a website discussed at the last meeting. Comm. Lovejoy Roe commented on an improvement to the website. She stated that she was disgusted by some of the other material on the website. She stated that she stresses talking to parents about their problems. She discussed the provision of abortion by the Planned Parenthood organization. Comm. Lovejoy Roe stated that she would like Commissioners to seek an alternate form of funding.

Comm. Grewal stated that she has heard from residents on both sides of the Planned Parenthood issue. She added that Planned Parenthood has been funded over ten years because of their positive record in the area of pre-natal care. She stated that this service is sorely needed in the community. Comm. Grewal stated that 40 % of clients are in the minority population. She added that the County does not provide direct pre-natal services.

Comm. Lovejoy Roe stated that with the exception of the past 3 years, infant mortality rates have risen within the prenatal program in Planned Parenthood.
