American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Regional Economic Impact Workforce Investment Act (WIA) National Emergency Grant

Comm. Prater seconded by Comm. Peterson moved to recommend that the Board of Commissioners approve the resolution ratifying the Chair of the Board's signature on the ETCS American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Regional Economic Impact (REI) Workforce Investment Act (WIA) National Emergency Grant (NEG) with the Michigan Department of Energy, Labor, and Economic Growth in the amount of \$762,252 for the period of October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010 be adopted.

Michigan Supreme Court – Michigan Drug Court Grant Program Award Revision

Comm. Prater seconded by Comm. Peterson moved to recommend that the Board of Commissioners approve the resolution to ratify the signature of the County Administrator on a grant contract with the Michigan Supreme Court, State Court Administrative Office, Michigan Drug Court Grant Program in the amount of \$40,000 for the period of October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010 to sustain the Washtenaw County Juvenile Drug Court be adopted.

Report of the Administrator:

Wireless Washtenaw Update

James McFarlane provided a brief update on Wireless Washtenaw. He stated that 20/20 Communications was selected to deploy the network. McFarlane reported that three pilots were built out. He stated that there have been economic challenges in the past few years. He reported that 20/20 applied for \$4.2 million in August from the federal government and added that they are still waiting for word on funding. McFarlane reported that infrastructure is needed to move forward. He stated that it is estimated that \$10 million would cover the entire County.

Comm. Ouimet asked if starting in the west and moving around is still the plan. McFarlane reported that the plan is currently to build out where infrastructure currently exists.

Comm. Irwin stated that there was a level of excitement that came with this project. Comm. Irwin stated that there were provisions in the contract the 20/20 had to meet that were not met. He stated that he was happy that the County stuck with 20/20. Comm. Irwin asked if anyone has approached to make the pitch to carry the project forward in a more successful way. McFarlane stated that there have been vendors that have had discussions. He stated that the thought process was to give 20/20 the opportunity.

Comm. Schwartz asked if there would be other sources for Wireless if 20/20 shut down all of the sudden. McFarlane reported that this is the main source of internet at this time. Comm. Schwartz stated that he would be interested in finding out what the alternatives are.

Comm. Ouimet reported that there would be no break before the start of the Board of Commissioners meeting.

Items for Current/Future Discussion

Comm. Gunn reported on the NSP funding. She stated that NSP 1 was received and the projects are underway in the City of Ann Arbor and in Townships. Comm. Gunn added that no funds were received from NSP 2. She added that the County will be applying for NSP 3.
