Peterson moved to recommend that the Board of Commissioners approve the resolution requesting that the Board of Commissioners ratify the signature of the County Administrator on the application for the Michigan Department of Human Services for Fiscal Year (FY) 2009 Community Services Block Grant American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funds in the amount of \$925,193 for the period of October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2010 be adopted.
