

## **SALEM TOWNSHIP PUBLIC NOTICE**

### **RECALL OF OFFICER WITH ELECTION DUTIES APPOINTMENT OF IMPARTIAL PUBLIC OFFICER**

On July 15, 2010, the Washtenaw County Clerk/Register's Elections Division officially determined that the minimum threshold of signatures had been met to hold a recall election on November 2, 2010 for Robert Heyl (Salem Township Supervisor) and Paul J. Uherek (Salem Township Treasurer) – both members of the Salem Township Election Commission.

On August 27, 2010, the Washtenaw County Clerk/Register's Elections Division officially determined that the minimum threshold of signatures had been met to hold a recall election on November 2, 2010 for David Trent (Salem Township Clerk) – a member of the Salem Township Election Commission and, as Clerk, Salem Township's chief election official.

Pursuant to MCL 168.965, Lawrence Kestenbaum, Washtenaw County Clerk/Register, has appointed **Frances McMullan (Ypsilanti City Clerk)** and the **Ypsilanti City Election Commission** to discharge the election duties for Salem Township as they relate to the November 2, 2010 General Election.
