Tabulator Warranty Information

Please be advised of the following update from the State Bureau of Elections regarding warranties for your new tabulators:

Earlier this year we advised that the warranty period on all tabulators covered the first two even numbered year election cycles immediately following purchase and delivery. It has since been brought to our attention that there are some variations in the contract terms depending upon the type of equipment purchased. Note that in each case, the expiration date is calculated from the date that the equipment was purchased.

At the end of the warranty periods listed below it will be the individual jurisdiction's responsibility to purchase extended warranty or maintenance coverage.

If your AccuVotes were purchased in 2004, the warranty on the tabulators expired at the end of 2006. If your AccuVotes were purchased in 2005 or 2006, the warranty on the tabulators will expire at the end of 2008.
