Election Day

Election Day is fast approaching – just a week away! We wanted to remind everyone that we will be uploading results here on Election Night so please bring in your memory cards, flash cards and envelopes that night. As the night progresses, please feel free to call us if you need assistance closing up any of your precincts. We have several “closers” trained and available to assist with trouble-shooting problems and closing up the polls.

For those jurisdictions with voters in out-of-county school districts, please contact those counties for information regarding Election Night procedures.

For questions regarding voters' polling locations please refer voters to the Washtenawvotes.org website. Also, the State has asked that jurisdictions check the QVF to be sure that polling location information for your jurisdiction is up to date and accurate. Many voters check the Michigan Voter Information Center website (which gets its data from the QVF) for polling location information. With several precincts having consolidated for this election, we should be verifying those locations.
