The possibility to do this will all police agencies and it will be researched further.

Chaffee gave a report on statistics from seven programs run in 2006-7. She stated that community corrections must establish projections for grants to present to the judiciary. There is a need to show beds saved. That has not been possible in Washtenaw County; however this has been the best year for community corrections. Discussion ensued.

Patton also informed the group of PA 139 and 140 that amend the jail overcrowding acts. Guenzel requested a memo to be drafted by Corporation Counsel to outline the legislation for the next meeting.
