### **Call to Order**

Vice-Chair Irwin called the meeting to order at 7:38am.

### **I. Approval of Minutes**

The motion to approve the minutes of the November 16, 2007, CJCC Full Council meeting was made by Ryan Fuller; all in favor.

### **II. Public Participation**

None.

### **III. Selection of Officers**

The motion to elect David Swartz as CJCC Chair and Jeff Irwin as CJCC Vice-Chair was made by Shea and seconded by Tabbey. The motion passed with all CJCC members in favor. Elected Chair Swartz took over as Chair of the meeting.

### **IV. Oath Cards**

Deputy Clerk/Register Jason Brooks administered the Oath of Office for CJCC members Bunten, Ryan Fuller, Moran and Shea.

### **V. State Budget Update**

Kirk Profit (GCSI) and Adrian Hemond (GCSI) provided an update on the State budget. Profit indicated that there is essentially a structurally balanced budget, with opportunity for input through May, and that the budget likely will finalize in July. He indicated that about 3.1 million is expected to come back to Counties this year for Revenue Sharing, with Washtenaw County scheduled to come back on in 2012. Profit said that State practice has been to move revenue sharing monies (statutory portion) to balance the budget, stating the need to develop more planfully for Counties.

Shea suggested that the CJCC create a short list of issues that the committee sees as relevant with State Budget implications. Bergman asked that fees associated with community corrections be considered for this list. Irwin indicated that the Board of Commissioners would be interested in this list input from the CJCC. Profit suggested that the CJCC work with Behen to take these issues to the BOC, possibly then going to Lansing to meet with subcommittee chairs/staff.

#### **VI. Jail Population Management Plan**

Swartz stated that the legislature has enacted a statute that allows local counties to draft their own jail management plan if the Sheriff, Prosecutor, Chief Judge of Circuit Court, and Chief Judge of a District Court (nominated by other District Judges) can agree to this plan. He indicated this group has met once and has a draft general plan, stating that this must be adopted by February 11, 2008, to satisfy the statute. This plan may be amended at any time, resetting its four-year coverage. Swartz stated that there is provision to review it once every three months.

#### **VII. Meeting Location and Adjournment**

The CJCC Full Council meeting location is being moved to downtown, 200 North Main, Lower Level Conference Room.

Swartz adjourned the meeting at 8:25am.
