3. BY-LAWS

Steve Hiller has revised By-Laws as per discussion by Full Committee. Next week will vote on recommendation to BOC and the Trial Court (both must approve). Two scenarios: one includes County Clerk, one not. (Judge Shelton was going to talk to the County Clerk).

Mr. Powell has question re: membership should read "County Public Defender". John agrees will make change.

4. 2011 LEADERSHIP:

John believes Sheriff would be great chair. John thinks non-institutional member should be Vice-Chair. Steering Committee's consensus (and all in attendance) is that the Sheriff

be nominated. Need to come up with Vice Chair. Mike Moran has been asked –has not gotten back.

5. JAIL REPORTS

Mostly data reporting process. Need to revive sub-committee. John has met with Rick. Makes sense to work on now as jail adds new JMS system. Barbara would like data to be as integrative as possible with Community Corrections and Courts--would like communication threads formalized.

Greg Dill: jail management of population doing well. Getting close to choosing new JMS system. Population —looking at maintaining operational capacity. John: Where is population coming from? Sheila: more people being sent to jail for programming. John inquired whether Community Corrections could write grants from private sector. John: Sheriff still has the vision for a residential probation center (will also need programming and money for). John: wonders if can integrate with MPRI on programming. Kristin: MACGO talks about having grant money possible—Kristin will look into. There is some money out there. Example: Sobriety Court.

Brian Mackie: we need to look at the whole system. DOC: prison commitment rates are going up. Felonies are creeping up—like the shootings in Ypsi Township. New Probation supervisors (Michelle Spivey and Bobby Brown).

Sheila: thinks relates to prison commitment rate—would like information at some point. Barbara: wonders whether CFS are up or down? Or, is it because there are fewer boots on the ground? Brian: there are fewer boots on the ground. John: need to decide what

to look at to define where we are (and then what it means). More police on the ground—effect on crime (does more deter crime?).
