- * Number of cases reviewed expressed as a % of total Medicaid (M) cases or non-Medicaid (N) cases served in the past year
- Criterion for determining that natural supports (NS) were **addressed**: Documentation in the current PCP that natural supports were discussed for one or more outcomes.
 - Criterion for determining that natural supports (NS) were **desired**: Documentation in the current PCP that the consumer expressed a desire for natural supports for one or more outcomes.
 - Criterion for determining that there is sufficient documentation describing the **specific steps** that the natural support person(s) will take: Clarity regarding who will be doing what to help the consumer achieve one or more outcomes. **Examples:**
Not specific enough: Johnny will be supportive of Jenny; **Specific enough:** Johnny will frequently encourage Jenny to talk about her day at work and praise her if she does so; **Unnecessarily specific:** Johnny will encourage Jenny to talk about her day at work at least three times per week during dinner and will say that he appreciates the renewed closeness he feels when she does so.

Not specific enough: Jenny will help Johnny with his medical appointments; **Specific enough:** Jenny will drive Johnny to appointments with his primary care physician and his podiatrist; **Unnecessarily specific:** Jenny will drive Johnny to appointments with his primary care physician and his podiatrist at least 75% of the time unless he neglects to express the renewed closeness he feels when she talks about work.
