
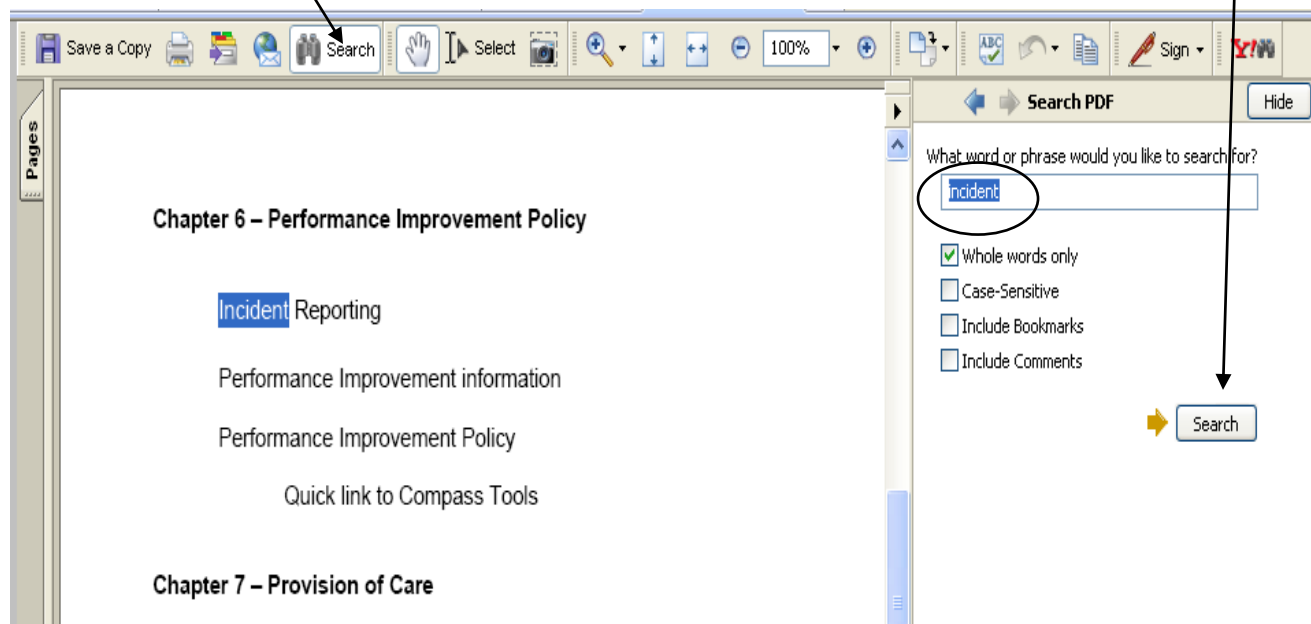


Example: How do I find the Incident Reporting policy in the Provider Manual?

1. Click the PDF search icon (binocular)
2. Type in the *Word/Phrase*: ex "incident"
