Nominations are now being accepted for free home repair.

Rebuilding Together – Washtenaw (formerly known as Christmas in April) is accepting nominations for homes in need of repair in preparation for the event Saturday, April 26, 2008. On that day, hundreds of local volunteers will work at 20 – 25 sites in Ann Arbor and Ypsilanti to do repairs, including electrical, plumbing, carpentry, roofing, and interior and exterior painting. Preference is given to those repairs that will improve the health and safety of home residents.

Nominee requirements are:

- 1) Home must be within the Ann Arbor, Dexter, Manchester or Ypsilanti school districts,
- 2) Owner(s) must be elderly, low-income or disabled, and
- 3) The owner(s) must live in the home.
