

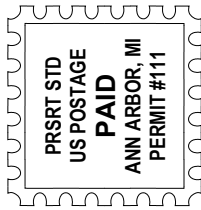
ServSafe® Training

ServSafe® training programs have been recognized and accepted by more federal, state and local jurisdictions than any other food safety education and training program for over 25 years.

ServSafe® was developed by the National Restaurant Association, and is a respected training and education program throughout the State of Michigan.

The *Michigan Food Law of 2000, as amended* requires all food service establishments to have at least one manager certified in food safety. Managers with the ServSafe® Food Protection Manager Certification meet this requirement.

As of April 2, 2010, any food service establishment operating without a certified food safety manager is in violation of the *Michigan Food Law* and will be subject to enforcement procedures.

Manager Certification

This 16-hour certification program provides food managers with thorough training in all areas of food safety relevant to today's food service establishments. After attending the course and passing an exam, managers will receive a certificate verifying that they are a certified ServSafe® Food Protection Manager. The *Michigan Food Law of 2000, as amended* requires all food service establishments to have at least one manager certified in food safety. Managers with the ServSafe® Food Protection Manager Certification meet this requirement.
