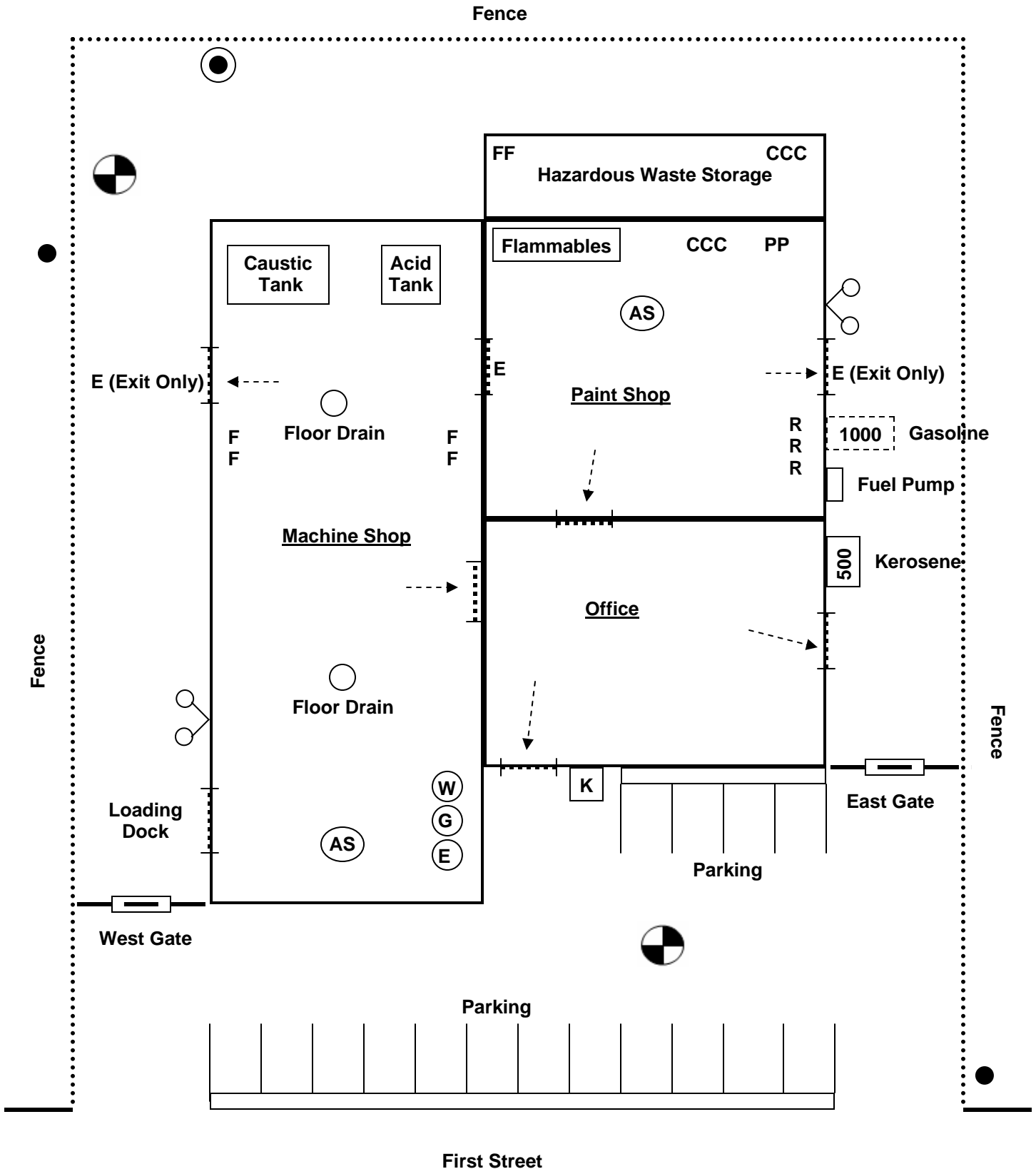
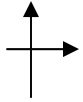














# SAMPLE SITE PLAN
